School Disco


Our 2nd school disco for the year will be held on Friday 21st October.

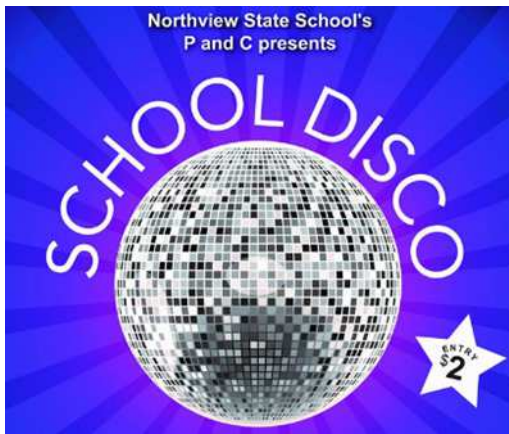

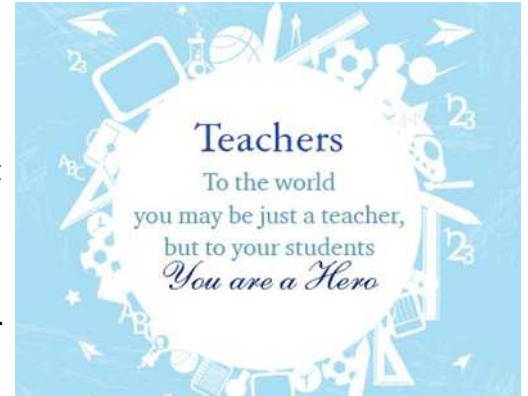
