NAPLAN individual student reports

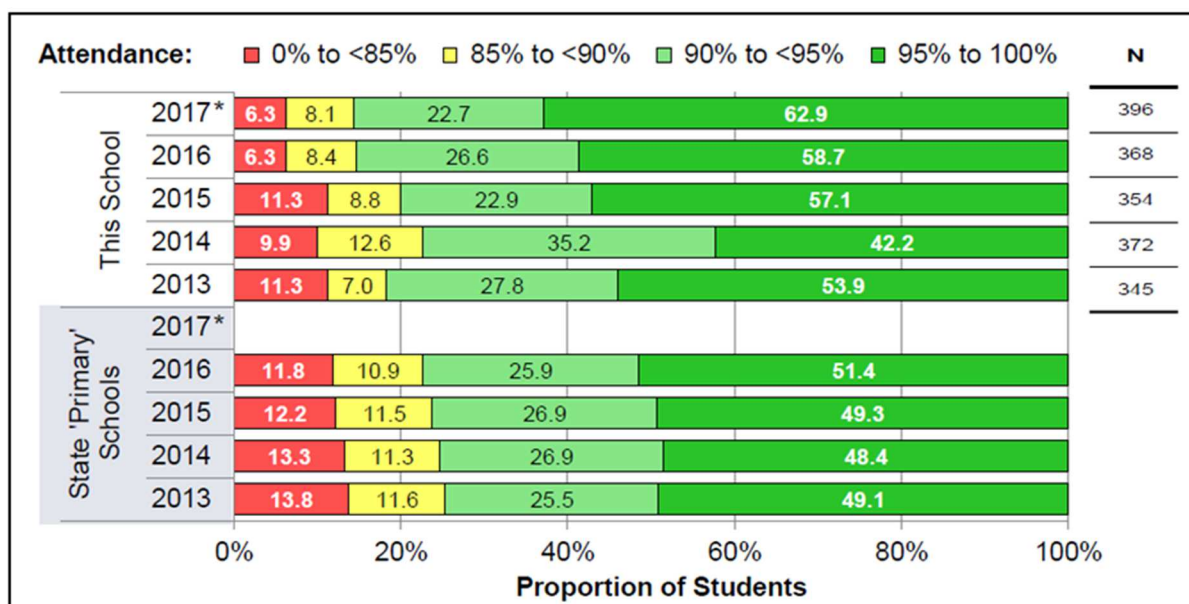
Yesterday our Year 3 & 5 students received their individual student NAPLAN reports today from testing completed back in May. If you have not received your child's report please contact our office.

Student attendance

Each semester our school receives a data profile from Education Queensland which gives an insight into our school's performance. As a community we should feel very proud of the improvement in attendance we have seen at Northview over the past few years. Currently we have 62.9% of students who have an attendance rate 95% or better. At the other end of spectrum we have only 6.3% of students who attend less than 85% of the time. It is widely reported in current research that a student attendance rate less than 95% will have a detrimental impact on their educational outcomes. Clearly a majority of our Northview families are valuing their child's education and ensuring they get value for money by sending their child to school every day, except when they are unwell.

Thirty-five students performed at the Hearing Awareness Week Seniors' morning tea on Tuesday 29th August at Souths Leagues Club. They performed a number of songs which were well received by community members - hearing and deaf alike. Feedback from the performance was very positive. A huge thank you to Anne Borg who sang a beautiful rendition of a song about what it is like to be deaf and how important it is to communicate and for all to be accepted and included in the community.

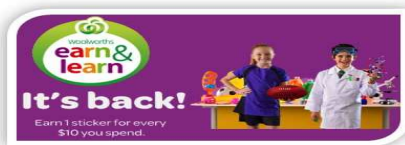
